 - A. **Exodus 4:29-31** Moses and Aaron gathered together all the elders, the people believed, they worshiped
- 2. Obstacles to breaking the bondage
 - A. Preparation
 - B. Consecration
 - C. Moderation
- 3. Preparation: Recognize the problem
 - A. Exodus 5:18 no straw, deliver the bricks
 - B. Exodus 5:20-21 made us abhorrent to Pharaoh
 - C. They were not yet prepared for deliverance {PP 260.2}
 - 1) had little faith in God
 - 2) unwilling patiently to endure their afflictions until He should see fit to work for them
 - 3) content to remain in bondage rather than meet the difficulties attending removal to a strange land
 - 4) many were unwilling to leave
 - D. God needed to contrast what they had with what they could have
 - 1) develop tyrannical spirit of king
 - 2) reveal Himself to His people
 - 3) they would choose to leave Egypt
 - 4) **Exodus 10:1-2** hardened his heart, I may show these signs, tell mighty things I have done, know that I am the LORD
 - E. They complained about God's solution
 - F. Today: Living in known sin?
 - 1) God shows us the problem
 - 2) Hardship and trials
 - 3) Do we complain?
 - 4) Do we want to leave Egypt?
- 4. Consecration: Everything for God
 - A. Exodus 10:8-11 Leave wife & kids
 - 1) keep women and children as surety {PP 271.4}
 - 2) Plagues of locusts and darkness (Exodus 10:12, 21)
 - B. Exodus 10:24 Leave flocks
 - 1) **Exodus 10:26** livestock shall go, we do not know with what we must serve the LORD
 - C. Today: Everything given to God?
 - 1) Willing to give earthly possessions to God?
 - 2) Religion and business separate matters?
 - 3) Is religion a family affair?
 - 4) Do we leave our families to do God's work?
- 5. Moderation: Don't go too far
 - A. Exodus 8:25-27 sacrifice in the land
 - 1) Do what God wants, but not the way He instructed
 - B. Exodus 8:28 don't go too far
 - 1) Moderation

- 2) Passover? {PP 278.2}
- C. Today: Don't be a fanatic?
 - 1) Lose your influence?
 - 2) None will follow your God unless you follow
 - 3) Moderation is bad when it comes to obedience
- 6. Have I removed excuse to stay in Egypt? Remain in bondage to sin?
 - A. Cannot remove excuse; doesn't exist
 - B. Problem is the DESIRE to sin
 - C. Without desire, excuse is irrelevant
- 7. Do you <u>WANT</u> to break free from the bondage of sin?
 - A. **Preparation**: Necessary hardships
 - B. Consecration: Give all to God you, family, stuff
 - C. **Moderation**: Go all the way, whatever it takes
