- 6. Ex 18:1-12 Jethro came with Zipporah and kids
- 7. **Ex 18:13-16** people stood before Moses from morning until evening; make known statutes of God
  - A. Tough life for Moses
  - B. Necessary work

- 8. Ex 18:17-18 not good; you will wear yourselves out
  - A. Two million people waiting
  - B. Was Moses being attacked? Yes
  - C. Moses was vulnerable because he was alone
  - D. Like stragglers in the back, leaders in the front need protection
- 9. Ex 18:19-20 you shall teach them
  - A. It was good for Moses to instruct people
- 10. Ex 18:21-22 select able men; bear the burden with you
  - A. Spread the work around
  - B. Choose the right people for the job
- 11. Ex 18:23 God commands you; people go in peace
  - A. Work goes much faster
  - B. People can get help they need
  - C. But it only works if God is in charge

  - A. Humility Moses accepted advice from Jethro
