1. Is God always loving?

A. God IS love, nothing separates us from love

2. Does the 2nd death show God's love?

- A. Yes, God's love is still manifested
- B. They would rather die

3. What happens at Christ's return?

- A. The saved go to Him:
 - 1. <u>1Thess 4:16-17</u> dead rise, meet Lord in air
 - 2. John 14:3 where I am, you may be also
- B. The lost do not want to be near Him:
 - 1. <u>Rev 6:15-17</u> fall/hide us from Him
 - 2. Luke 23:30 fall/cover us!

4. Why hide?

- A. <u>Gen 3:7-10</u> fig leaves, hid, afraid of nakedness
- B. <u>Gen 3:11-12</u> Have you eaten? The woman.
- C. 1Tim 2:14 Adam not deceived
- D. Rom 8:7 carnal enmity, not subject to law
- E. Eph 2:3 by nature children of wrath

5. We need to be saved. From what?

- A. Penalty/Power/Presence
- B. Pleasure we like sin

6. Problem: WHAT we are, not WHERE we are

A. All your problems involve YOU

- B. If taken to heaven as we are naturally:
 - 1. Hide, torture for us, rather die
- C. God loves us, but we hate Him
 - 1. <u>1John 2:15-16</u> lust of flesh, eyes, pride of life
 - 2. James 4:4 friendship w/ world, enmity with God
- D. We love sin
 - 1. If you got to heaven, would you like it?

7. Solution: Transformation, not transportation

- A. We need to be converted
 - 1. Changed from what we are to what we should be
- B. Carnal mind enmity, not subject to law of love
 - 1. Mind needs to be changed
 - 2. <u>Rom 12:2</u> be transformed, renew mind

8. Beyond human power

- A. <u>Jer 13:23</u> leopard change spots?
 1. Outward change is not enough
- B. <u>Titus 3:5</u> not works of righteousness, mercy
- C. Eph 2:8-9 saved by grace, not works
- 9. What does it look like? Do whatever you want?
 - A. Eph 2:10 created for good works
 - B. <u>Titus 2:11-12</u> saving grace, teaching us...

10. Why did Jesus come?

- A. <u>Titus 2:14</u> redeem, purify
- B. <u>1John 3:5</u> take away sins, in Him no sin
